

## Casios Pathfinder/Protrek, the PRW-5000

If you are interested in watch that promises high-performance, comes with truckload of feature and a tough look at the same time, Casio's Pathfinder/Protrek, the PRW-5000 will be your only console. Though PRW-5000 has retained the same homegrown features of, its innovative touch is palpable in the design it has got.

The newest addition to the pathfinder design of PRW-5000 is the analog hands. The previous designs of had a pathfinder series used to come with a second LCD layer but PRW-5000 has replaced with a second hand. This second hand has been invested with a number of responsibilities acting as compass needle, showing the altitude and the barometric pressure. While you can know the direction directly from the needle positioning on the cardinals, the second hand's movement on an orange inset stretching along the dial's edge between the cardinal point 11 and 3 will give you the altimeter and barometric reading. If you care to go through the manual, you can readout the barometric trend from a graph in the LCD.

In other words, with Casio's analog-digital watches you can get these details both from the LCD and the needle approximation simultaneously. This watch will be greatly helpful to for fisherman and sailors as both the LCD and the analog hands response to the slightest changes with great accuracy.

If you are using PRW-5000 at night you need to have certain changes in the functioning. If the LED backlight turns on at six o'clock, the dial is brilliant lit and you need to make the barometric graph visible in LCD by pressing Adjust.

You need not turn your head off worrying about the battery life when you are dazzled with the brilliant radiance of the LED backlight. Pathfinder PRW-5000 is solar powered.

Now, to spend a few words about the outer appearance and the comfort factor of PRW-5000, it must be admitted that the case, case-back and the straps have maintained the Casio standard. The outer case in stainless steel bezel and four decorative screws have given it a look too hard to ignore. Moreover, its durability, water resistance and quartz-accurate time reading, have made Casio's Pathfinder/Protrek, the PRW-5000 a must for those who does not where they will be the next moment.
